Waste Disposal Guidelines For The Residents Of The Village Of Shiloh

Trash:

- **Trash disposal is limited to container only.** Material outside of the trash container will not be serviced. Additional trash containers can be leased from Republic Services for \$4/month. Contact Customer Service to request your additional trash container.
- At the time of initial start-up of service, residents have the choice of either a 95 gallon or a 65 gallon trash container. If a resident wants to exchange this container for either a larger or smaller size after this initial request, they can exchange 1 time free of charge by March 31, 2018. Effective April 1, 2018, a delivery fee will be incurred.

Recycle:

- Recycle service is now an automated service with Republic Services containers. It is still an optional service; therefore, interested residents can call Customer Service to enroll.
- **Recycle service is now serviced 1 time, every-other-week, instead of weekly.**
- At the time of initial start-up of service, residents have the choice of either a 95 gallon or a 65 gallon recycle container. If a resident wants to exchange this container for either a larger or smaller size after this initial request, they can exchange 1 time free of charge by March 31, 2018. Effective April 1, 2018, a delivery fee will be incurred.
- **The 18 gallon recycle bins are no longer acceptable containers for recycle service.**
- Recycle disposal is limited to container only. Material outside of the recycle container will not be serviced. Additional recycle containers can be leased for \$2/month. Contact Customer Service to request your additional recycle container.

Yard waste:

- Yard waste is still an optional service that is serviced 1 time/week all year long, with a 3 month minimum commitment to service. **The maximum number of containers to be set out for service is 8 containers/week.**

Personalized Household Cleanups Replace Week-Long City-Wide Cleanups

- Effective January 2018, there will be no city-wide cleanups in the Village of Shiloh.
- Instead of the city-wide cleanups, effective January 2018, each residential unit will have the flexibility to schedule 2 personalized cleanups per calendar year, at no cost.
- Each of the 2 personalized cleanups can be scheduled by calling Republic Services customer service representatives prior to setting items out curbside. Please do not contact the Village of Shiloh to coordinate the personalized cleanup.
- When residents call into customer service, the representative will provide the resident with the exact date to set the items out curbside. The date given will be within 7 days from the call-in.
- Residents need to be prepared to provide a general list of items they want to include in the cleanup.
- Personalized Cleanup reminders:
 - » **Items included in personalized cleanups are intended for household items only;** therefore, no construction materials or materials resulting from a home remodel/demolition.
 - » All nails, staples or anything sharp that is exposed must be removed
 - » All items, outside of household furniture, must be contained in a plastic bag:
 - Bagged item piles cannot exceed an area of 4x4x4
 - Bags cannot exceed 50lbs each

- Acceptable items included in personalized cleanups:
 - » Appliances
 - » Carpet: cut into bundles no longer than 4' in length and 3" in diameter and weighing less than 50lb per bundle
 - » Furniture: couch, chair, dressers, tables, desk, etc
 - » Glass portions of doors/windows: must be broken down and placed into small box marked "glass."
 - » Mattress sets
- Unacceptable items that are not included in personalized cleanups:
 - » Basketball sets/poles, unless they are broken down into sections and no larger than 3" in diameter.
 - » Batteries
 - » Concrete and construction material of any kind
 - » Electronic waste: televisions, computer monitors/accessories, DVD/VCR players, etc.
 - » Fluorescent light bulbs
 - » Lead/oil based paint/varnish
 - » Loose trash or trash in cardboard boxes
 - » Tires
 - » Yard waste

Bulk Disposal: After residents use their 2 personalized cleanups, a bulk item pickup is a minimum of \$50 and it must be prepaid and scheduled through customer service.

Appliance Disposal: After residents use their 2 personalized cleanups, the cost of an appliance pick up is \$35/appliance. It must be prepaid and scheduled through customer service.
